

**CLINTON COUNTY MASTER GARDENERS
VEGETABLE CONTEST**

1. Entries must be brought to the south room of the auditorium between 9:00AM. & 12:00 Wednesday, July 14th.
2. Contest is open to rural and urban exhibitors of Clinton County.
3. Entries limited to **one per class** for each entrant
4. All entries must be grown by the entrant
5. Entrants may enter as many classes as they wish
6. Each entry must be clearly marked with Name, Class, Address, Telephone number
7. Plates for vegetables will be provided
8. Judging is from 1:00 Wednesday, July 14th until completed and is **closed to the public**
9. Each class will be judged as follows: 1st (blue ribbon), 2nd (red ribbon) 3rd (white ribbon)
10. A “Best of Show” ribbon will be awarded, accompanied by the Lorraine Gustafson Memorial Award and traveling plaque
11. Unworthy entries will not be judged
12. Entries may be picked up any time after noon and before 5 PM, Saturday, July 17th. Any entries not picked up will be destroyed
13. All reasonable caution will be used to protect entries, but neither Clinton County Master Gardeners nor the Clinton County Fair Board will be responsible for theft or damages.

The exhibit will be judged 75% for the quality of the vegetables, and 25% for the decorative arrangement.)	

Herbs

30	Parsley (3 sprigs in a bottle of water)
31	Any other individual herb (3 sprigs in a bottle of water)
32	Collection of 4 herb species displayed in separate bottles of water. Specimens should include 3 sprigs with stems of adequate length for each species.
